



WEBINAR REPORT on Renewable Energy and Energy Management towards Mitigation of Climate Change

A Webinar on the topic "Renewable Energy and Energy Management towards Mitigation of Climate Change" was organized by RKDF University, invited speaker Dr. Surendra Bajpai MP Urja Vikash Nigam Ltd. (Certified Energy Auditor from BEE) on 05th June 2020 at 11:30 P.M delivers his lecture by Zoom Platform.

In the beginning of the webinar Dr. V.K Sethi, Director General (Research), RKDF University, Bhopal explained about the Renewable Energy. The invited speaker Dr. Surendra Bajpai well explained that most renewable energy sources produce little to no global warming emissions. Even when including "life cycle" emissions of clean energy (ie, the emissions from each stage of a technology's life—manufacturing, installation, operation, decommissioning), the global warming emissions associated with renewable energy are minimal. Also Dr. Sethi explained about the supply of renewable energy would allow us to replace carbon-intensive energy sources and significantly reduce US global warming emissions. They found that renewable energy could help reduce the electricity sector's emissions & about global warming.







A Brief Summary of Live Webinar Series

Under the guidance of University Vice Chancellor Professor Dr. Sudesh Kumar Sohani and the Chief Patron of the webinar, the Honorable Chancellor of RKDF University, Dr. Sadhna Kapoor, a webinar had been organized jointly by the Faculty of Commerce, Arts and Humanities & BCA on "Challenges and Opportunities of Providing Employment: With Special Reference to Emerging COVID19 Scenario" on 6th June 2020. The Convener of this webinar was the Dean of Commerce, Arts and Humanities, Prof. Dr. N.K. Shrivastava.

The resource person of this webinar was Dr. Mukesh Jain, Prof. of Commerce Institute for Excellence in Higher Education, Bhopal. In his talk he covered the history of various pandemics occurred at the global level from 1665-66 to 2019-2020, and the number of deaths occurred during these periods. He cited the example of great plagues of Landon (1965-1666), Russian plague (1770-1772), American polio epidemic (1916), Asian flu (1957-58) and so on.

Further he focused on the problem of Indian economy; he said that particular in India high population growth is the major problem that is leading to many other problems including high unemployment, poor education, poor infrastructure, balance of payment, and high level of private debt, high income inequality, large budget deficit, and poor tax collection and so on. He cited the example of Malthusian theory of population growth in which Malthus explains that the population growth is potentially exponential while the growth of food and other resources is linear.

Further he covered the various initiatives taken by the Government of India under the Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan to short out the problem of Indian economy. He also talked about the importance of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise (MSMEs) and their contributions to the growth of GDP and a vital role in providing employment opportunities to the large number of people. In the last slide he emphasized on the strengths of the Indian economy that includes the low cost of living, diversity, demography, well-educated youth, political stability, international relations and our culture.




Report on webinar
