3. Finalization of elective subject of different disciplines, their name, codes are as mentioned in point No. 5. The elective subject will include all the advances in the relevant field with respective PG specializations of the discipline and subject code will be PhD12XX (in place of XX initial letter / Identifying letter of the discipline would be included. For example, Pharmaceutical Sciences -PS will be used)
4. Finalization of syllabus of compulsory subject as mentioned in Appendix-I
5. Finalization of syllabus of elective subject(s) of various discipline are attached at appendix-II
6. Finalization of teaching scheme of course work is mentioned in Table 2
7. Course work examination scheme is finalized and shown in Table 3
